## PGFC SENIOR ACADEMY - TALENT IDENTIFICATION REGISTRATION OF INTEREST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **How do I register for the talent ID?**

Please click on the link provided and you will be directed to our online portal for trial registration. Click on the relevant age group and follow the instructions through the Checkout.

*All information is required to be eligible.*

### **Can I register via email?**

No, all trial registrations must be completed online, to ensure our coaching staff have all the required information.

### **Does the Club get in contact me once I register?**

Yes, you will receive our confirmation of trial participation letter with the trial information if you are accepted via email provided which will also include our FAQ no later than 22 October 2024.

### **What does my child need to bring?**

To be ready with proper footballing attire, black shorts and black top, boots, shin pads, bottle of water.

### **What does my child do when he arrives at the venue?**

Approach Perth Glory Coaching Staff to confirm his attendance.

### **Who will be assessing my child throughout the trials?**

Perth Glory Technical Director together with the Perth Glory Academy Coaching Staff.

### **Do I need to accompany my child onto the field?**

No, the coaching staff will look after all potential players.

### **What ages can register their interest to trial?**

Only NPL players born in 2007/08/09 may register their interest in trialling.

### **When will I be notified if my child has been selected to trial or not?**

All registered players will receive an email once the registration period has closed (2 weeks from release).

### **What about players from outside of WA?**

Players from out of state wishing to trial are welcome, however will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

### **What are the training times for senior academy?**

Senior Academy Training takes place 4 times a week, training times to be confirmed.
